From the Secretary's Desk:



Grand Lodge will be sending out the dues statements for the new Lodge year 2023-2024 at the beginning of February. For those of you who haven't paid your current year's dues, you will see both the current year dues and the new lodge year's dues on those statements. Be aware that if you haven't paid your dues, you are not entitled to any of the privileges enjoyed by Members. Section 14.160 of Grand Lodge Statutes covers all the specifics. If you get dropped for nonpayment, you can get reinstated within 60 days if you pay all your dues. After the 60 days, you will have to complete a Request for Reinstatement and pay the reinstatement fee. Keep in mind that if you are dropped for nonpayment of dues, you can't come to the Grill Room even as a guest. These are Grand Lodge rules that every lodge has to honor.

There is a lapsation list posted on the bulletin board in the Grill Room. If you know someone who is on the lapsation list because they have fallen on hard times (perhaps because of illness or lack of employment), please reach out to a lodge officer so we can find a way to help them out.

You will see the Elks Charity Tickets listed on your dues statement, but they are not enclosed. That's because Grand Lodge sends out our dues statements and they won't enclose anything from any of the lodges. If you wish to purchase Elks Charity Tickets, I have them in the office and will be bringing them out to the Grill Room for you. Fill them out and return them to me for handling.

Also, please return the ENTIRE statement with your dues payment so we know how to allocate your payment. That's it! Thanks for reading all the way to the bottom!

Speaking of lodge officers, February is nominations month. If you, or someone you know, would like to get involved in the rituals/operations of our Elks Lodge, talk to an officer to get into nominations. We have two Lodge meetings in February, March, and April to nominate, elect, and install new officers.


