Attention issues hamper their ability to focus while distance learning and quarantining at home without their usual therapies and outside activities are worsening behavior problems. Add to that the anxiety of catching the virus by some of our most vulnerable, immunocompromised children and you can see why COVID-19 is making life difficult for these families.

Connecting for Kids has fielded a record number of calls asking for help over the past year. By bowling at this event, you will not only have a great time with fellow Lodge members, but you also will be providing much-needed funds so that we can support area families with education and resources for their child.

All bowling will be socially distanced with only eight people in the bowling alley at one time. (Two teams of four will use opposite ends of the alley).

### **ELKS COST:**

\$200 minimum donation per team of four bowlers. Because the Elks are generously donating the bowling, 100% of your donation goes directly to Connecting for Kids.

# From the Lodge Secretary's Office...

FYI – Grand Lodge had a major problem with the Chicago Post Office, as well as the printer of the dues statements (there is a slight possibility that a few dues statements are wrong). I was informed by Grand Lodge that both issues have been resolved, and the dues statements are being sent out asap. Here are a few things you should know:

- 1. Basic dues for the year is \$106.75. Be sure you return the dues statement with your payment so I know how to post your dues. This is because there are add-on options like the Elks National Foundation (ENF), which is usually \$10, CP (Cerebral Palsy), and the Ohio charity raffle tickets.
- 2. You can pay your dues at the Lodge. Drop your sealed envelope in the safe by the door. Make sure you spin it so the envelope drops into the safe.
- 3. You can pay your dues with a credit card. There will be credit card payment forms at the Lodge on the table by the door in the Grill Room. Also, there should be the form at the bottom of the dues statements as in the past.
