

### Hello, everyone!

Grand Lodge is sending out the membership renewal notices. A couple of things to keep in mind:

- 1. Please return the full copy of the notice with your payment.
- 2. We are required by Grand Lodge Statutes and Lodge Bylaws to pay the following per capita amounts in addition to the \$85 regular member dues: Grand Lodge and State Association is \$26.50 and the District is .25 (25 cents). The total required is \$111.75 for regular members. It is different for Life Members. Life Members will see their total on their renewal notices.
- 3. If you are making additional contributions, please check the box and write how much you are donating. The minimum for Elks National Foundation is \$10; for Cerebral Palsy it is \$2; and the State endowment is \$1.00.
- 4. The Elks Charity tickets are \$5 each or 3/\$10. Just like last year, they are not enclosed in your envelope. I talked with Grand Lodge, and they can't do it. Although the tickets are for our State charity drawing, the State Association can't send them out to individual members either.

So, here's what happens if you choose to buy the Elks Charity tickets: I fill out all the ticket stubs with your name, address, and lodge number. I then mail all the stubs with our payment to the Ohio Elks Association before the April deadline. The winners are pulled at the April Spring Convention in Columbus.

Don't forget to buy your tickets for the Installation of Officers dinner and party before they are gone! It's a fun time and a great way to start the new Lodge year.
