MEMBERSHIP REPLACEMENT CARD

We will be delaying the new card access until May 1. This will allow us more time to process your membership fees which are due in by April 1. You will receive an access card in the mail and a letter explaining more the closer we get to May 1.

In addition, some options to the new system are as follows:

- There will be a mobile app available to download for a onetime fee of \$6.00. This is payable to the Mobile App provider directly. When doing this your new key card must be returned to the lodge. Note if you get a new phone the Mobile App will need to be reloaded for an additional \$6.00.
- We will have key fobs available for your keyring for an additional cost of \$10.00. Again, if you select this option your new key card must be returned.
- There is an option to have a swipe device attached to your phone. This adheres directly to the back of your phone or protective case. The additional cost will be \$ 10.00.
- Any replacement cards will have a charge of \$10.00.

The reason for the changeover is that our current system is no longer supported, and currently-issued key cards will be discontinued soon. Additional information will be coming soon as to the above options.

This is another improvement being made for the betterment of Lodge 1350. Thank you for your support and patience during this transition.

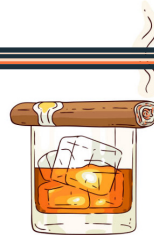

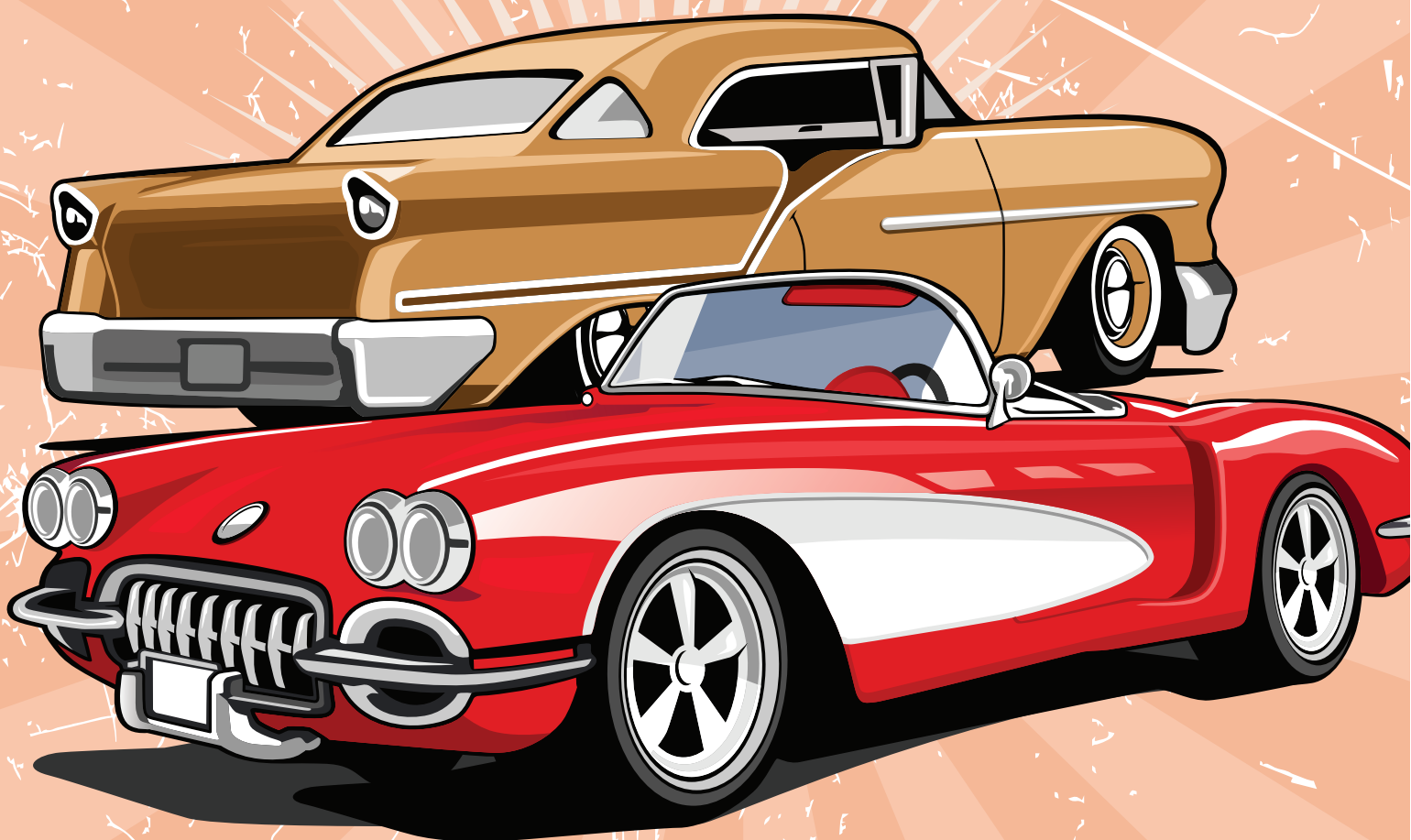
