Turn left onto Parkcenter Circle (This will be the 2<sup>nd</sup> left).

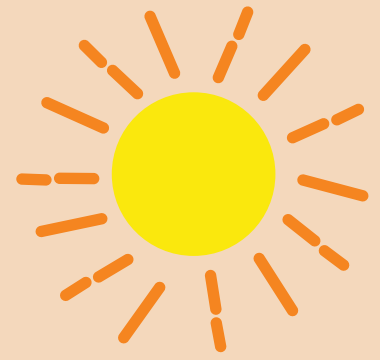
