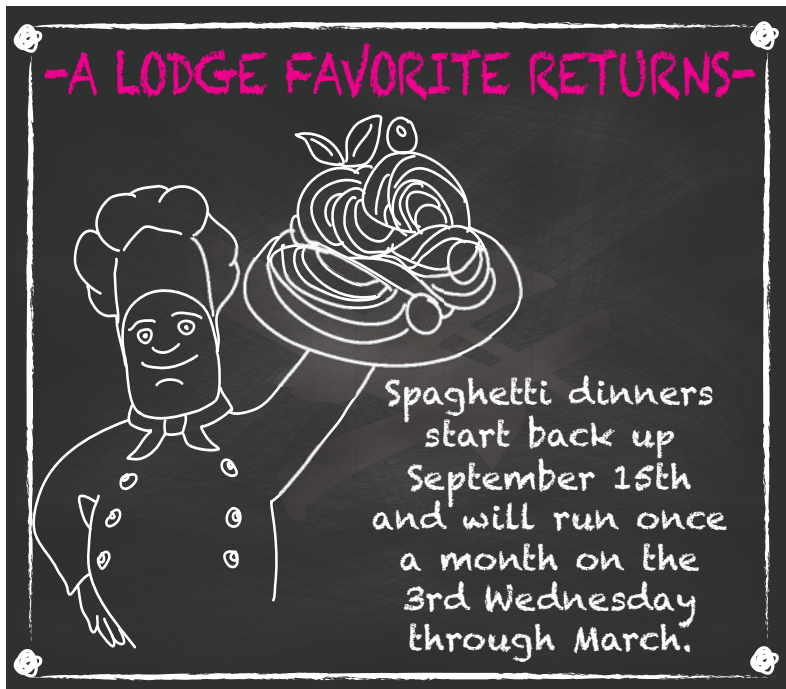

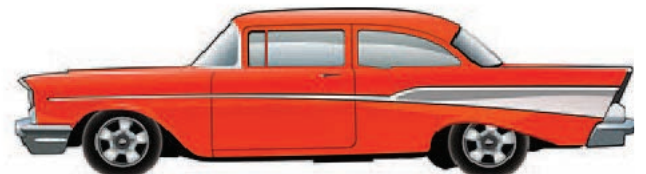

Turn left onto Parkcenter Circle (This will be the 2nd left).

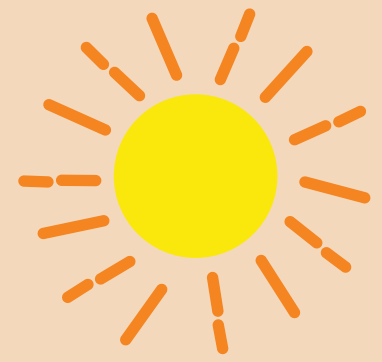
