

We are three-quarters of the way through our current Lodge year. Time flies, doesn't it?

Memorial Service is on Sunday, December 3rd, at 1:00. This is where we honor those members who have passed on during the previous year. The list of members to be honored is on the In Memoriam page elsewhere in this Ledger.

There have been some questions regarding membership application procedures lately. Here are the steps to becoming a member of the Elks: 1) A Member in good standing proposes the applicant. The proposer is expected to be able to vouch for the applicant and be with the person throughout the process; 2) the applicant's name is printed in the Ledger and read on the Lodge floor at the next Lodge meeting; 3) the applicant receives a letter stating the date and time of the investigation; 4) if the applicant is favorably investigated, they are presented to the Lodge for balloting-this is a vote of the members to allow the applicant to join or to reject the application; 5) if approved by the lodge membership at balloting, the applicant will then proceed to the orientation/initiation phase; 6) orientation is usually held two days before initiation and provides a time for discussion of what the Elks represent, as well as opportunities for involvement in activities; and, finally, 7) Initiation. This is where the applicant becomes a Member in good standing with the rights and privileges of membership. If you have any questions, or would like to get involved with investigation, please contact the ER Ruth Ann Witteman.

To those who have submitted membership applications: please read the letter you receive very carefully. It will tell you the next steps in becoming a member including dates and times for each step. If you can't make it to investigation (which is the first step) on the date stated in the letter, please call the office at the number above and we will try to make alternate plans.


